

Diversity in assessment – why Xerte?

- Develops student digital literacy skills.
- Encourages staff to develop rich multimedia content with interactivity that will improve the learning experience and engagement.
- Easy to use interface based on page templates that requires no technical knowledge
- Cross-platform authoring tool e.g. mobile friendly
- Xerte learning objects can be re-used. Linking to current Scottish Open University project promoting the use of open source resources. (OEPS)

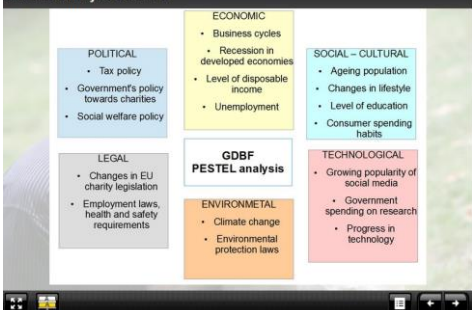
Our Idea: Insight Initiative-Part 1

Our first idea for encouraging public donation is to organise a 'blind walk'. This involves a fully-trained Guide Dog, or one in the later stages of training, aiding members of the public on a walk at various locations such as ... whilst blindfolded. The dependence on the Guide Dog to guide individuals along a specified path, accompanied by the trainer or a volunteer, will provide first-hand insight into what having a dog brings to a visually-impaired individual.

This event could be taking part nationwide or even become an annual event. The proposition is aimed primarily at local schools and councils to get involved and spread the word throughout the community.

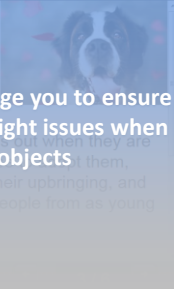
This will not only generate awareness but can create an understanding among people of the needs that a blind or partially sighted may have and/or the problems they may encounter.
